Skill Level: Advanced Beginner**Gauge:**

- ❖ 8 sts x 7 rows = 2

General Supplies:

- ❖ Yarn – worsted weight in three colors
- ❖ Hook – H (regular), J (Tunisian) OR size needed to obtain gauge
- ❖ Tapestry Needle
- ❖ Yarn bobbins (optional)

Abbreviations and stitches required:

- ❖ ch: chain
- ❖ sc: single crochet
- ❖ tss: Tunisian simple stitch
- ❖ sl st: slip stitch

Notes:

- ❖ In single crochet, odd numbered graph rows will be worked right to left, and even numbered graph rows will be worked left to right.
- ❖ When working in Tunisian each row has a forward and return pass. All graph rows will be worked right to left.
- ❖ To finish off in Tunisian, sl st across the last row.

- ❖ There is a picture at the end of this pattern to show how I count my sts for Tunisian as it was brought to my attention that it is different.
- ❖ Can size finished measurement is approximately 8 inches in gauge.
- ❖ Cup size finished measurement is approximately 9.75 inches in gauge.

Single Crochet to fit can

Row 1: Ch 17, sc in second ch from hook and each ch across. (16)

Row 2-4: Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (16)

Row 5-24: Ch 1, turn. Work graph starting at bottom right corner. (16)

Odd numbered rows on the graph will be worked right to left, and even numbered rows on the graph will be worked left to right.

Row 25-28: Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (16)

Finish off and weave in ends. Go to finishing section.

Single Crochet to fit cup

Row 1: Ch 17, sc in second ch from hook and each ch across. (16)

Row 2-7: Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (16)

Row 8-27: Ch 1, turn. Work graph starting at bottom right corner. (16)

Odd numbered rows on the graph will be worked right to left, and even numbered rows on the graph will be worked left to right.

Row 28-34: Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (16)

Finish off and weave in ends. Go to finishing section.

Tunisian to fit can: When working Tunisian each row has the forward and return pass. Each row on the graph is read right to left.

Row 1: Ch 17, tss in 2nd ch from hook and each across. (16)

Row 2-4: Tss. (16)

Row 5-24: Tss. Work graph starting at bottom right corner. (16)

Row 25-28: Tss. (16)

Finish off and weave in ends. Go to finishing section.

Tunisian to fit cup: When working Tunisian each row has the forward and return pass. Each row on the graph is read right to left.

Row 1: Ch 17, tss. (16)

Row 2-7: Tss. (16)

Row 8-27: Tss. Work graph starting at bottom right corner. (16)

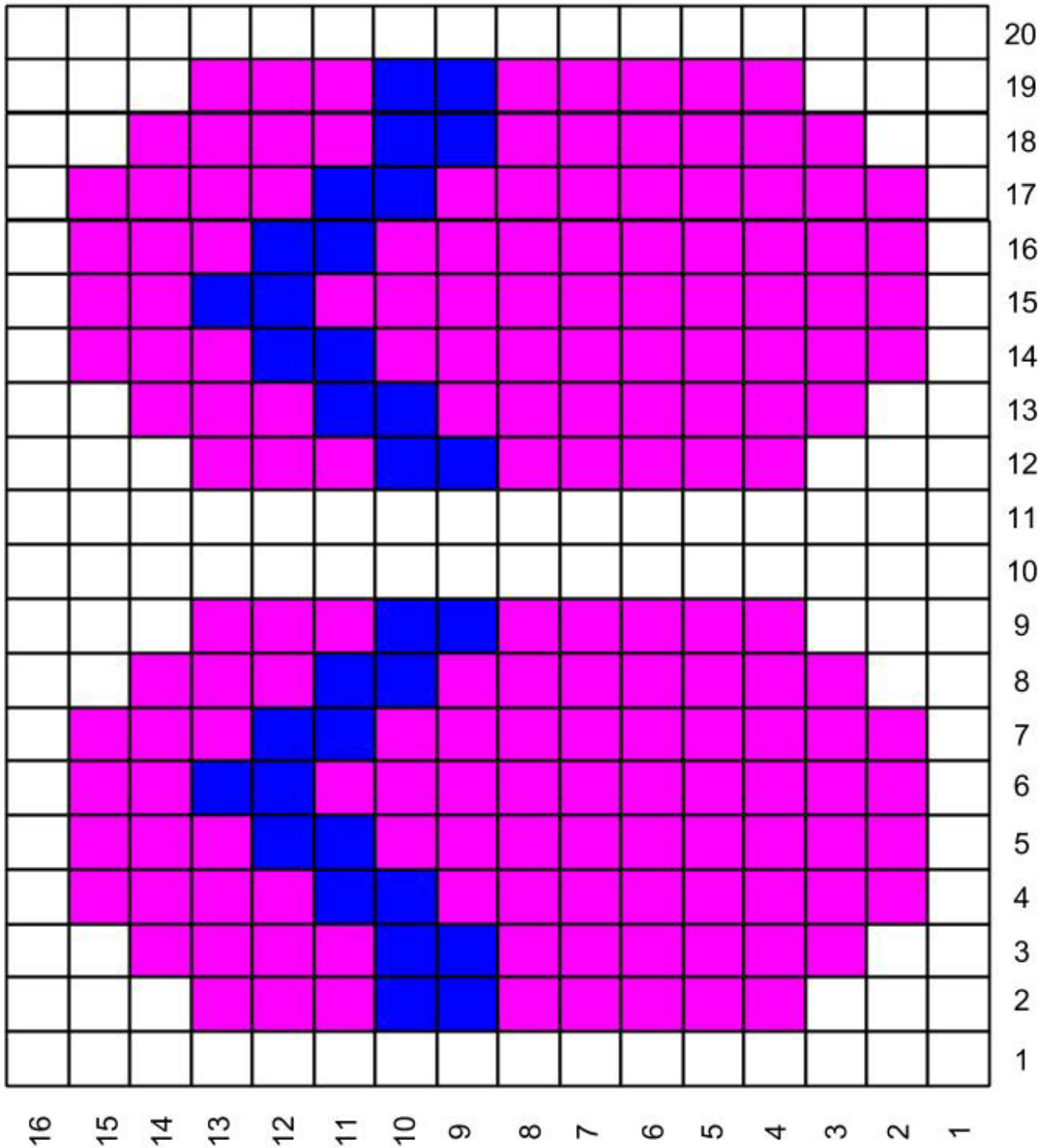
Row 28-34: Tss. (16)

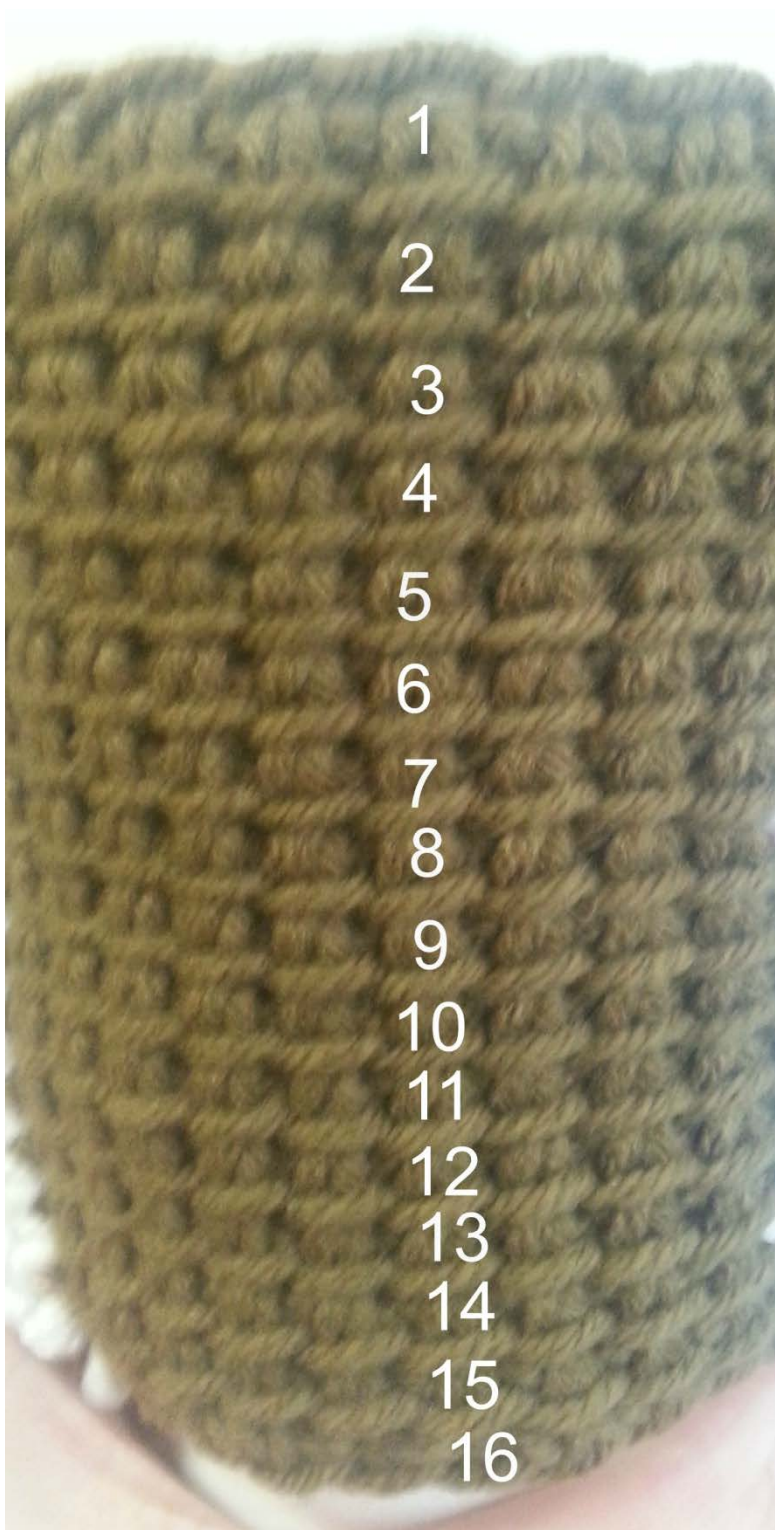
Finish off and weave in ends. Go to finishing section.

FINISHING

Using a tapestry needle, mattress seam or whip stitch short ends together. Or sl st ends together using hook.

Join yarn with sl st at top of seam and sc evenly around top edge. You should have the same number of sts as rows worked. Repeat for bottom edge.





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
