

A Poppy in the Storm

A Cre8tion Crochet Original



The A Poppy in a Storm Super Scarf is created using Boutique Infinity Yarn by Red Heart Yarns. I designed this scarf as part of a collaboration with the other Red Heart Joy Creators for the [Super Scarf Blog Hop](#). Joy Creators are a group of designers and crafters who combine innovative designs and ideas with Red Heart products to create joy. Super Scarves are wildly popular for this Fall and Winter Season. A Poppy in the Storm looks great in one color, two colors, or more. There are no limits when it comes to this mega scarf.

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YARN

2 Skeins of Red Heart [Infinity in Thunder](#)

1 Skein of Red Heart [Infinity in Poppy](#)

129 yards/118 meters, 3.5oz, 100grams; Bulky #5, 69% Acrylic, 11% Wool, 10% Polyester, 6% Nylon, 4% Metallic

MATERIALS

N/9.0mm Hook- I use the [Plum Candy Shop hook from Furls](#)

Yarn needle

DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE

11” wide by 88” long before fringe

GAUGE

8 rows and 1 pattern repeat = 5 ½”

STITCH GUIDE

ch(s) – chain(s), sc – single crochet, hdc – half double crochet, dc – double crochet, st(s) – stitch(es),

NOTES

- Ch 3 at beginning of row is considered the first dc



PATTERN

Row 1: FHDC 161

Row 2: Ch 6 (considered first dc and ch-3) and turn, skip 2 sts, sc next st, ch 4, skip 3 sts, sc next st, ch 3, skip 2 sts, dc next st, *ch 3, skip 2 sts, sc next st, ch 4, skip 3 sts, sc next st, ch 3, skip 2 sts, dc next st, repeat from * to end.

Row 3: Ch 1 and turn, sc in same st, *, skip next ch-3 and sc, [ch 1, dc] 6x into ch-4, ch 1 skip next sc and ch-3, sc in next dc, repeat from to end (last sc will be placed in the 3rd ch of beg ch-6). Change color at the end of this row.

Row 4: Ch 3 and turn, (on this row you will only be crocheting into ch spaces, ignore all dc sts unless specifically mentioned), dc in each of the next 3 ch-1 sps, ch 2, sc in next ch-1, ch 2, * dc in each of the next 6 ch-1 sps, ch 2, sc in next ch-1, ch 2 repeat from * until 3 ch-1 sps remain, dc in each of the next 3 ch-1 sps, dc in the last sc.

Row 5: Ch 5 (considered first dc and ch-2) and turn, skip 2-dc, sc in the next dc, ch 3, (skipping all chains) dc in the next sc, ch 3, (skipping all chains) sc in the next dc, *ch 4, skip next 4-dc, sc in the next dc, ch 3, (skipping all chains) dc in next sc, ch 3, (skipping all chains) sc in the next dc, repeat from * until last 3-dc, ch 2, skip next 2-dc, dc in the last dc.

Row 6: Ch 3 and turn, dc in the same st, [ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1] into ch-2, skip next sc and next ch-3, sc in next dc, skip next ch-3 and next sc, *[ch1, dc] 6x into ch-4, ch 1, skip next sc and next ch-3, sc into next dc, skip next ch-3 and next sc, repeat from * until last ch-2 and last dc, [ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1 into ch-2, 2dc in the 3rd ch of beg ch-5 from previous row. Change color at the end of this row

Row 7: Ch 1 and turn, (on this row you will only be crocheting into ch spaces, ignore all dc sts unless specifically mentioned), sc in same st, ch 2, dc in each of the next 6 ch-1 sps, * ch 2, sc in next ch-1, ch 2, dc in each of the next 6 ch-1 sps, repeat from * until last two dc, ch 2, skip next dc, sc in last dc.

Row 8: Ch 6 (considered first dc and ch-3) and turn, skip ch-2, sc in next dc, ch 4, skip 4-dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, skip ch-2, dc in next sc, *ch 3, skip ch-2, sc in next dc, ch 4, skip 4-dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, skip ch-2, dc in next sc, repeat from * to end (last dc will be placed in last sc of row).

Rows 9-14: Repeat rows 3-8 one time more.

Row 15: Ch 2 and turn, 3hdc in ch-2, dc in next sc, 4hdc in ch-4, dc in next sc, 2hdc in ch-2, *sc in next dc, 2hdc in ch-2, dc in next sc, 4hdc in ch-4, dc in next sc, repeat from * to last ch-3 space, 3hdc in last ch-3, hdc in the last st.

Row 16: Sl st in every st across. Fasten off, weave in ends.

FINISHING

Cut fringe in 21” length (finished fringe will be approx. 10” long). You will need 96 lengths of yarn to get the same affect I have. I did 15 sections of fringe, one at the end of each row. The color code is below

Fringe Section 1-3 – three lengths of CA

Fringe Section 4 – two lengths CA and one length CB

Fringe Section 5 – three lengths of CB

Fringe Section 6 – two lengths CA and one length CB

Fringe Section 7-9 – three lengths of CA

Fringe Section 10 – two lengths CA and one length CB

Fringe Section 11 – three lengths of CB

Fringe Section 12 – two lengths CA and one length CB

Fringe Section 13-15 – three lengths of CA
